She was a recipient of the Institute for Health and Healing's "Pioneers in Art, Science, and the Soul of Healing Award," and is a Diplomate of the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology. She was in two acclaimed documentaries, the Academy-Award winning anti-nuclear proliferation film *Women – For America, For the World,* and the National Film Board of Canada's *Goddess Remembered*.
